

Mrs. Nugent was associated with the Carpenter & Camputy National Advertising firm and represented associations throughout the likewest with offices in Chicago and New York. She was also active to a warner's advertising class of Chicago and New York.

to 1918 the Lincoln Courser Herald was parchased and the advertising agency maintained Mrs. Numeric became publisher of the Courter after the death of her husband (Carpenters in 1925. She wrote arlicies on travel under the "My Colome" heading. The advertising agencies were sherged with her brother Hugo, to become the Scheerer and Company firm. After his tenth, she devoted full time to building the Courser mto a fine small town daily newspaper in 1928, Mrs. Nugeni parclassed the Lincoln Star and the two newspapers merged.

The Onurier Herald used rented quarters on N Kirkupon Street and moved to the IOUF building in 1923. The office was moved to the present building to 1939 and the was har own architect, planning the entire building. The present building was built from a number of smaller business buildings which were parchased by Mr and Mrs. Wagert.

Mrs. Nugeril was a member of the illimous Board of Pardons and Paroles. She was artive in helping to establish the Pirst National Bank in Lincoln and was also active in the dedication and ground work for the City Gateway, built by labor of this community who durated their efforts. Governor and Mrs. Green were among many state digistaries to attend the dedication revenumes and the program received national publicity

Mrs. Nugent had always been interested in the bet terment of the community and the Courier promised many things, including the Logan County fair queen, the Jumor Good Chinese, Man of the Manth and Year programs and helped organize the Logan County Mather of Twice club.

In a statement published in the Courier Aug. 26, 1963, the evening of the Lincoln centermini, Mr and Mrs. Nugeral set forth guidelines for their publishing philosophy. The statement follows

We take pride in being a part in seeing that people are kept informed. We will contimize to challenge the community in its welfare drives, in relation to the exercise of the ballot and in relation to its needs. While appreciating what we have we must not forget what we should have

"It is our mission to bring the world to-your discristep for either a hurried glance a lessurely perusal, or a concentrated study. We shall chronicle who was born, who died, and who was married. We will product the weather provide results of sports contests, and in various other ways offer a varied reading menu for your information and entertainment.

Nor will we releast in assisting the development of Logan County in civic economic educational religious, social and cultural progress in the days before us in this way we shall do our part to promote better life and better living for the people of this great community

Mr and Mrs. Nugent retired from a long and active life in the newspaper field when they sold the Lancoln Evening Courser to William V. Jovowner of the Centralia Sentinel. Since the Courser publisher has been James L. Fetgatter, who is also business manager of the Centralia daily. When the paper changed bands, the name was changed to Läncoln Courser.




